| 2003 | Iraq – Led firefighting team at the start of Iraq war to control six sabotaged wells. |
| 1997 | Midland, Texas – Capped and controlled blowout in one day, which was two miles south of a major U.S. airport. |
| 1995 | India – Controlled massive gas blowout and fire in record time. |
| 1994 | Northern Wyoming – Controlled high temperature and pressure H ² S well. |
| 1991 | Kuwait – Logged more days than any other blowout specialist; instrumental in controlling 123 burning wells as project manager for Red Adair Company. |
| 1988 | North Sea – Controlled the multi-well Piper Alpha disaster where 168 lives were lost. Responsible for killing 36 wells, 12 of which were burning. |
| 1985 | Gulf of Mexico – Controlled multi-well platform fire and removed rig. |
| 1983 | Hungary – Part of the team that capped the world's largest thermal blowout. |
| 1979 | Villa Hermosa Mexico – Assisted in controlling one of the largest fires in Red Adair Company history. |
