The *Agribusiness* TravSources includes technical bulletins, risk management guides and more that can help customers in the business of agriculture reduce their risk of loss related to chemical exposures, heavy machinery use, hauling product, among other things. Customers can access the TravSources by logging in to the Risk Control Customer Portal, clicking on the TravSources link and then choosing “Agribusiness” from the industry drop-down box.

New Postural Assessment Technique Materials

The *Postural Assessment Technique (PAT) Guidelines and Form* (#169) has been updated. The guidelines and form include new updated images. The PAT form should be completed, at a minimum, for every job that results in an OSHA 300 log musculoskeletal injury/disorder that is classified as an ergonomic injury. It also is recommended that the PAT form be completed when assessing operations that have employee complaints or discomfort, are scheduled for relocation/renovation, or have productivity or quality issues. Access the guidelines and forms by logging in to the Risk Control Customer Portal and searching “postural assessment” in the Advanced Search function.
