EDUCATION ACCESS INITIATIVE

The Travelers Education Access Initiative, launched in 2007, is a program designed to remove the barriers to college that underserved students face and help students progress from middle school to a rigorous high school curriculum which will prepare them to enter college able to compete on an equal level with their peers. Professional development and mentorship opportunities are also in place to build an awareness of, and to help students access, careers in insurance and financial services, providing them with a competitive edge to career success. In 2008, Travelers allotted nearly \$2M to the Travelers Education Access Initiative including grants and other support to these organizations:
