Small Business Risk Education

In 2012, Travelers launched the Small Business Risk Education program (SBRE), in the Los Angeles/San Fernando Valley area of California. By the end of 2019, the SBRE program reached more than 2,331 small business participants in multiple locations across the country. SBRE provides insurance literacy and safety risk management education to minority- and women-owned small businesses. The program includes workshops, one-on-one assistance focused on safety risk management, and business continuity planning.
