## DRIVERLESS CARS

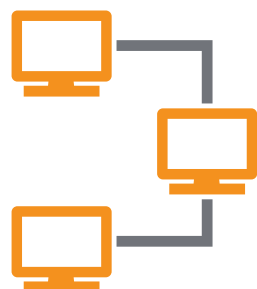
Manufacturers and owners of autonomous vehicles could be held liable for bodily injury or property damage after an accident.

## INTERNET OF THINGS

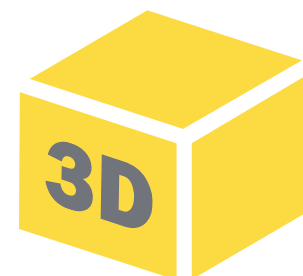
“Connected” equipment increases the chance for unwanted access to systems and puts production machinery and intellectual property at risk.

## 3D PRINTING

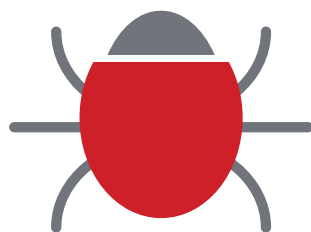
Trade secrets, patents or other protected information used in 3D printed objects can create intellectual property liability.
