GOLF CARTS

Impaired or underage drivers and passengers increase the risk of golf carts tipping over or crashing into pedestrians.



2

THEFT

Golf clubs or other personal items left unattended on the course or in the parking lot can be stolen or damaged.

HOSPITALITY

On-site restaurants and banquet facilities have unique liquor liability and food safety concerns.



4

TOURNAMENTS

Charities and sponsored events lead to more foot traffic and increase the likelihood of slips, trips and falls.

YOUNG PATRONS

Junior golfers attending lessons on-site create unique liability concerns for the golf course as well as their instructors.



6

WEATHER

Severe weather can cause injury to players or considerable damage to a golf course, forcing it to shut down for repairs.
