

# 6 OCEAN CARGO RISKS THAT CAN DISRUPT SUPPLY CHAINS

**1****COMPLIANCE**

Failure to understand and comply with in-country/foreign insurance laws can incur costly delays.

**2****CLAIMS**

Getting claims settled fairly and quickly in a foreign country can be challenging without access to local claim agents.

**3****FOREIGN WAREHOUSING**

Substandard facilities and procedures can increase the potential for damage and theft of goods in storage.

**4****THEFT**

Cargo is always susceptible to theft, with a higher likelihood in countries like Mexico, parts of South America, and Eastern Europe.

**5****POOR PACKAGING**

Failure to ensure goods are properly packed for in-transit conditions can result in damage that is easily preventable.

**6****THIRD PARTY RISKS**

Allowing shipping agents or storage providers to handle insurance coverage can result in terms and deductibles that don't fit your needs.
