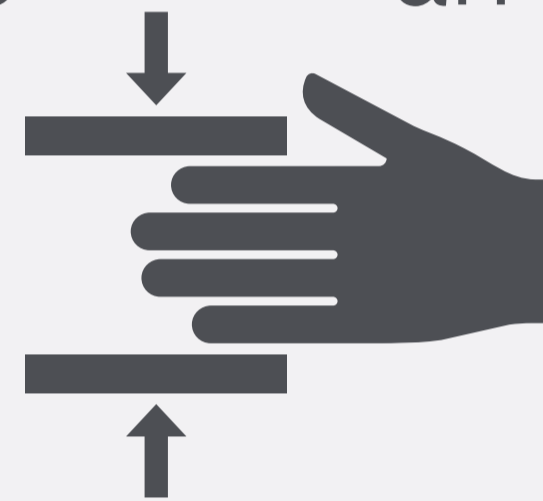

Average number of days wholesale workers missed due to workplace injuries: **67**.

Top five most common resulting injuries:



43% Strains and sprains

12% Fractures

8% Contusions

Employees with **less than one year** in their roles represented **35% of all wholesale workers compensation claims**.
